Accessibility and Project Goals

New Websites will have a Monsido score for:

- Accessibility 83%
- Quality 93%
- Readability 8th grade or below for the top 10 agency web pages



Design System

Lullabot has built the Iowa DX Platform based on our goals.

The design system in D9 (soon to be D10) is built with guardrails to help deliver a high quality usable experience for our constituents.

Guardrails include:

- enforcing required fields and structure for accessibility.
- limiting field length for usability and readability.



Five Accessibility Checks for Migration

Page title is appropriate length - Target less than 75 characters

Monsido Accessibility Error - Title is short <u>Title Video</u>

Title describes the document - title of the document and link must be unique and descriptive of the document.

Link text is meaningful when read out of context - text is specific to the page or document.

Five Accessibility Checks Continued

Tables - Identify pages with tables to determine if content needs to be rewritten or a table summary

Monsido Accessibility Error - All complex data tables have a summary

Decorative Images have correct alt text

Monsido Accessibility Error - Alt text for all img elements is the empty string ("") if the image is decorative.




Structured Content

- Content is data.
- DX platform shifts the content creator experience from basic pages to creating small content pieces which can be reused on many pages.
- Reusing content means there there is only one place to update information a single source of truth.



Structured Content - Sortable and Filtered with Taxonomy and Listing Pages





Taxonomy

Taxonomy is a system of categorization. The "Topic" data element is where you will use taxonomy in the platform.

Limited agency staff will have the permission to create agency taxonomy (topics).

Whenever possible, assign your content to a topic. Select up to two or more topics.



Taxonomy Continued

System Taxonomy

News Type - Press Release or Standard.

Document Type - Document, Form, Publication

Alert Type - Notice or Warning

Agency Manager have the ability to add additional Taxonomy Terms



Taxonomy Homework

Create a list of categories (topics) for your website.

Enter your taxonomy before you start to enter content.

Enter taxonomy under Structure > Taxonomy

Select list terms

Review plain language training and other resources in the ServiceNow Knowledge Area.

Summary Field

Summary Field is a teaser - 160 characters maximum


This is the meta description used for search engine optimization.

- Appears on Google Search
- Displays in lists

What's Different? Most old websites automatically copied the first few sentences into the meta description. You will want to create a new, relevant, description/teaser.

Micro Content

MICRO-CONTENT



Accordion

This is a micro-content type, to be used as part of other content pages.



\wedge

Alert

High-priority message displayed as a banner at the top of designated pages.





Automatic List

Create an automated list of up to six content pieces. Use filter and display options to customize, with an optional click-through link to a full list or other content. Good for news, event, or document teasers.



Callout

Combination of a title, description, and optional image which can be displayed in different formats.



Link

A link within a Visual Link Collection.





Link Collection (List)

A list of links with optional descriptions. Contains a header and optional description to contextualize them. Less graphic than Visual Link Collection.





Combination of a headline, description, image, and link which can be displayed in different formats.

Statistics

Bold, visual statistics related to this content. Provides insight and helps move the eye down the page. Add up to three sets of statistics in the group.





Step

Describes each actions the user needs to take to complete a "How Do I?" guide.



Video Promo

Combination of a headline, description, video, and link which can be displayed in different formats.




Visual Link Collection

A list of links with images per link, arranged in a visual grid. Contains a header with the option to hide it.



Promo Micro Content

Use the Promo - Landing Page; Basic Page



Intro Title - 35 characters

Title - 75 characters

Description - 75 characters

Link text - 50 characters



Statistic

Select Dark, Light, or White

Add up to 3 statistics

Title - up to 70 characters

Statistic - numerical up to 8 characters

WYSIWIG Editor Tool Bar

Basic Page:

H2, H3, H4 |Bold Italic Quote| Link Anchor| Bullets Media Embed |Special Embed |Table Linebreak



Not all content will have this same toolbar. The embed and table feature are not available in news or micro content.





Images

Image Resources: https://go.iowa.gov/vtKu

Images automatically crop. Cropping occurs based on the focal point. Upload the "best quality" image and set the focal point if the center is not the focal point.

Receive notification during image upload if the image is too small.

Hero

Minimum of 1440 x 604. Ideally to scale for retina requires double the size 2880px (wide).
